Application Process



Food truck operators are required to submit a permit application to Hurricane City Recreation, providing a minimum of one week advance notice in order to operate in the parking lot. Food truck spots will be reserved on a first come first serve basis.

The application must include the following information:

- Name of the food truck
- Contact information of the owner or operator
- Menu
- Proof of liability insurance
- Copy of health department permit
- Copy of a business license
- Copy of vehicle registration

Permit Fee

All food trucks must pay a permit fee of \$50 per week to operate in the parking lot. The permit fee must be paid before the food truck is allowed to operate in the parking lot.

Hours of Operation

Food trucks are allowed to operate in the parking lot from 10:00 a.m. to 9:30 p.m. On the last day of their reservation, food trucks must vacate the premises by 10:00 p.m.

Parking Space

No power or water will be provided. Food trucks will be assigned a specific parking space in the parking lot. Food trucks are not allowed to park in any other space or block other food trucks. There are 4 parking spots that will be allowed for rental a week at a time, Monday-Sunday.

Noise Level

Food trucks must comply with city noise ordinances and keep the noise level to a minimum. This includes generators and any music played from the food truck.

Waste Disposal

Food trucks must provide their own trash and recycling containers. All waste must be properly disposed of at the end of each day. The parking lot will NOT provide a dumpster for food truck waste disposal.

Health and Safety

All food trucks must comply with health and safety regulations set by the local health department. This includes regular inspections of the food truck and proper food handling practices.

Cleanliness

Food trucks must keep their vehicles and surrounding areas clean at all times. This includes regular cleaning of the kitchen, equipment, and exterior of the vehicle.

Advertising

All signs displayed on food trucks must comply with Hurricane City's Sign Ordinance Sec. 10-36-3. Food trucks are allowed to display their business name and logo on their vehicle. No other advertising is allowed in the parking lot.

Violations

Failure to comply with any of the policies listed above may result in revocation of the food truck's permit to operate in the parking lot.

Restrictions

Hurricane City reserves the right to restrict or limit the operation of food trucks during certain weeks or periods of the year, particularly when there are special events or festivals taking place. These restrictions are often put in place to manage the flow of traffic, ensure public safety, and provide a better experience for attendees of the events.

Everything listed above is subject to change.
