



2024 Hurricane Recreation Volleyball Rules

The objective of this league is to provide recreational volleyball for youth 3rd – 8th Grade. This league is designed to teach players the fundamentals of the game while providing a noncompetitive, non-threatening environment focused on fun and learning.

Rules:

1. A match will consist of 3 games. First two games will be played to 25 (cap at 27). Third game, if necessary, played to 15 (cap at 17). Tournament games for 7&8 grade will be the best of the 3 with no cap for all games.
2. All games will be 6v6. Can play with 4.
3. The Home team will serve first. If a third game is needed the serve will be determined by rock, paper, scissors or coin toss between team captains and under the direction of the referee.
4. Time between games is 1 min.
5. There is a 5 point service rule. After 5 consecutive serves the ball will then change to the opposing team. This is designed to make sure all players get a chance to serve and play.
6. All players must be awarded sufficient playing time and should play every position on the floor. There can be no benching of players for missing practices or lack of skills.
7. Please have you and your players arrive early so they have time to warm-up and games can start on time.

Court Size: 60 ft x 30 ft

Ball Size: 3rd-4th Grade – Vollelylite
5th-6th Grade - Vollelylite
7th-8th Grade – Regulation Size Volleyball

Serve Line: 3RD-4th Grade – Taped line 20 feet from net
5th-6th Grade – Taped line, 25 feet from the net
7th-8th Grade – Official end line (30 ft from the net)

Net Height: 3rd-4th Grade- 6'6" ft
5th-8th Grade- 7'4" ft

Officials:

- The decisions of the official regarding the game are final. The official may change any decision prior to the restart of the next play.
- Any issues with the official need to be brought to the sports coordinator.

Coaches Conduct: Hurricane City Recreation Department expects all coaches to exhibit a certain standard of conduct. Please remember this league is structured as a non-competitive league, and although the kids should want to win we do not encourage that to be the only purpose of the game. Please refrain from any foul language, arguing with the ref or engaging with other coaches or players in a non-respectful manner. Any parents, coaches or players who use foul language or become disruptive to the game will be asked to leave the facility.
